EXERCISE 04

October 22nd, 2015

Ex_04a (SW): *30 minutes*

- Obtain a 21x21 cm square from the A4 size paper
- Produce a two-dimensional “figure” by folding the square sheet
 - Avoid the basic geometric shapes (square, rectangle, triangle, hexagon, etc.)
 - Do not tear or cut the sheet
 - You may use glue to attach the folded parts of the elements if necessary
- Produce exactly the same figure by folding a 13x13 cm white sheet
- Produce exactly the same figure by folding a 9x9 cm white sheet

Ex_04b (SW): *90 minutes*

- Make a balanced composition using CONTRAST as the main theme with the figures you have produced.
 - Produce more of these figures; the size of the new ones cannot be different than those that you have produced.
 - The total number of elements for your composition will be eleven (11).
 - Use A3 size black cartridge paper as the visual field.

Ex_04c (HW): *October 26th, 2015 / 14.00*

- Make a composition using the same method of production for its elements
 - Use colored A4 sheets to produce the folded elements (Single color + white)
 - Start with the A4 sheet instead of the square
 - Use only 3 different size for the elements
- The minimum number of elements should be thirteen (13).
- The size of the visual field should be 29x29 cm.
- Determine the tone/color of the background in HARMONY with the elements.
