**EXERCISE 04**

**Ex\_04d (SW):** *Two hours*

- Make a two-dimensional composition within the boundaries of an A3 size visual field with the concern for the color combination. Pay attention to the HARMONY of color and shape of the elements.
  - Produce two different types of two-dimensional figures by folding the square and/or rectangle sheets
  - Figures will be made out of colored sheets and grey or beige sheets
  - Figures of the same shape will all be the same size
  - Decide for the background color in relation to the elements of the composition
  - You may use glue to attach the folded parts of the elements if necessary

**Ex\_04e (HW):** *November 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2015 / 14.00*

- Make a composition using the same method of production for its elements
  - Consider raising some parts of the elements from the flat surface, not exceeding 2 cm
  - Decide for the shape, color and size of the elements
- The minimum number of elements cannot be less than thirteen (13).
- The size of the visual field should be 35x50 cm.

**Material required for the next class (November 2<sup>nd</sup>, Monday):**

- White drawing paper
- Drawing instruments, COMPASS is a must
- Colored pens and pencils
