
**Ex\_05a** (**SW**): *60 minutes* 


#### Make the following drawings <u>using your compass</u>

- Do not erase any one of the guide lines
- Pay attention to the line thickness and line quality
- Keep the tip of your compass and your pencil sharp
- Work on sketch paper until you become sure of your drawings
- Submit the final copy on a 35x50 cm white drawing paper
- Pay attention to the organization of the final sheet
- Draw any straight line; draw another line perpendicular (with 90° angle) to that
- Draw any straight line; divide the line into two equal parts
- Draw two intersecting straight lines and obtain an angle; divide the angle into two equal parts
- Draw any straight line; draw another line parallel to that
- Draw four (4) circles, each with a radius of 5 cm; with in one of these circles draw:
  - A hexagon
  - An equilateral triangle
  - A square
  - An octagon

Ex\_05b (SW): Three hours

- Draw one of the patterns given below on 24x24 cm white drawing paper
  - The diameter for the circles should be 6 cm
  - Use 2H pencil and keep the tip of your compass sharp





## **Ex\_05c** (**HW**): *November* 5<sup>th</sup>, *Thursday*

- (1) Draw one of the patterns above on a 24x24 cm white drawing paper PRECISELY
- (2) Following the lines of this grid (pattern), make a new pattern
  - Make number of sketches on separate sheets of sketch (tracing) paper using this pattern as an underlying grid
    - Add straight lines passing through the already existing points
    - Let some of the existing lines remain as guide lines (eliminate some of the existing lines)
- (3) Draw the pattern you have designed on a 24x24 cm white drawing paper
  - Make number of sketches on separate sheets of tracing (sketch) paper and try different color combinations
- (4) Produce the colored copy of the pattern on a 24x24 cm paper
