

Aim: Practising on the basics of C; using switch-case

1. Write a program that prints the following:

A	A ²	A ³
3	9	27
4	16	64
5	25	125
6	36	216

HINT: Use ‘t’ and ‘n’ in `printf()` ;

2. Write a program that reads an integer (between 1-12) and prints out the corresponding month name. If the user enters an integer less than 1 or greater than 12, the program will print “Wrong entry” message.

HINT: Use switch-case for selecting an operation

Sample output 1;

```
Please enter an integer: 2
2. Month of the year is February
```

Sample output 2;

```
Please enter an integer: 10
10. Month of the year is October
```

Sample output 3;

```
Please enter an integer: 35
Wrong entry.
```
